Fiscal Impact Analysis of The Grantham Tract Subdivision

1. Project Description

The Grantham Tract is a single family residential community planned for development of 95 acres of land in Northern Chatham County. The project includes 74 lots on which homes of approximately 3,000 square feet will be constructed. The estimated average sales price is \$450,000.

2. Executive Summary

The Grantham Tract will increase the Chatham County residential real estate tax base by \$33.3 million. As outlined below the Grantham Tract subdivision will have a positive net fiscal impact on the Chatham County Government and the Chatham County School system.
