Thank you for following up your telephone call of several weeks ago about the property off Mt. Gilead Church Road east of the Haw River church. As I mentioned to you then, I have visited the family cemetery on the property with permission of Mrs. Danek but did not measure it. I'm sure the surveyors will do that more accurately than I could manage.

The cemetery is on the north edge of a level place where there are stone foundations of a former structure. I would appreciate an opportunity to visit the site to photograph these artifacts. While I think they might make an attractive feature for a future owner, I cannot make a recommendation that they should be preserved. I know of no other historical structures on the site but hope that, should other traces of former occupation be discovered, I might be informed in order to document them for the Chatham County Historical Association.
