My husband, Steven Esthimer, and I would like to add our concerns to those expressed by our neighbor, Barbara Dickinson. She emailed you suggesting that turn lanes and changes in the speed limit would add to the safety of people living in the subdivision, and their neighbors. While traffic on Lystra Road may not be heavy by relative standards, the road is used as a connector by many people, speed limit is ignored and not enforced, and the hill close to the subdivision's entrance/exit will make it difficult for people to see cars coming toward them on Lystra Road.

I understand from reading documents prepared for the Chatham County Planning Department's meeting that the need for turn lanes and changes in the speed limit are matter for the NC DOT. We hope that the developer will bring these concerns to the attention of the DOT.
