Mark--

Jim and Bev Wiggins and I walked down the easement at the Bailey tract on Sunday and on down a short distance south to see if an old road (probably a logging road but rather open and not heavily rutted) led anywhere. At the edge of the clearing where what appear to be salvaged construction materials are stored was a trash pile, a pile of rocks, and a bravely blooming patch of daffodils. I think these may be the vestiges of the "old Crump place" referred to in an earlier deed as the destination of the easement. A Civil War officer, Capt. J. J. Crump (1823–1917), and his mother are buried in St. Bartholomew's church cemetery in Pittsboro. A John J. Crump was an attorney in Pittsboro in the 1880s and 1890s was involved in a number of real estate transactions, all of which I have not yet tracked.

I would suppose that logging has obliterated most of the signs of human occupation in this area, but perhaps as survey crews visit more of the tract other indications may be found. If so, we would appreciate the opportunity to visit them.

Thank you for allowing us to visit the property and for being sensitive to the local history of Chatham County.
