This tract appears to be part of what was originally the B. G. Lambeth home place (over 500 acres). The parcel is only 90 acres and the proposed subdivision cuts down that acreage still farther. If any evidence of former occupation is discovered as further surveys are made, we would very much appreciate the opportunity to photograph it.

Another interesting note in an earlier deed (K-J, p. 23) reserves for ten years the right to take and use rocks and stone from the property. We would also be interested to document any evidence of this, such as rock piles or excavation.

The Chatham County Historical Association appreciates your sensitivity to the preservation of local history.
