Thank you for contacting the Chatham County Historical Association about your plans to develop parcel 19333. We understand that you are aware of no structures or gravesites on the property. You did mention that a former structure was destroyed about 40 years ago. If any evidence of this structure remains, we would like the opportunity to evaluate the site for artifacts before the area is disturbed.

As I mentioned in our conversation, evidence of former human habitation often surfaces only after the land is more thoroughly examined. Should you find such evidence, in the form of structures or their remains, or gravesites, as your project moves forward, please contact the Chatham County Historical Association right away. Our interest is in preserving or documenting these traces on the land of former us and occupancy.
