I. Summary

At the request of Lewis Metty Development Company LLC, a Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) was preformed for a 162 acre site in Chatham County, North Carolina (PIN #'s 9756-26-2681.000, 9746-95-7113 and 9756-15-6332.000). The site is owned by Charles E. Lewis, of Lewis Metty Development Company LLC and located in Pittsboro, south of Orange/Chatham county line, and south-east of Jones Ferry Road. A portion of the property's western boundary is defined by Meadow Branch, perennial stream. A site map, which includes a 2002 Chatham County GIS aerial photograph, is included with this report (Exhibit A).

The ESA performed for this site was completed in accordance with ASTM Practice E 1527-05 and included interviews with current owner, past owners, research of environmental database records, historical records and a site visit. Additionally, adjacent properties were visually evaluated while traversing the subject property boundaries, via windshield survey and/or through evaluation of historical aerial photographs.

The majority of the site is covered by mature forest vegetation that has been thinned. The remainder of the site is covered by successional forest vegetation at varying stages of maturity. There are several piles of logged trees scattered throughout the property. One old logging path exists that begins below the southern property line and leads northeast to an old home site, located in the northwestern portion of the subject property. Around the old home site are several piles of trash including glass, tires, etc. During the initial site visit, minimal debris was observed throughout the property. This debris included trash, and other debris typical of rural properties. According to the Bynum, NC, USGS topographical quadrangle map, the subject site disposes the majority of its storm water runoff into Meadow Branch and the rest to eastern and southern adjacent properties. This assessment has revealed no evidence of major recognized environmental conditions in connection with the subject properties.

An environmental database report for the property was supplied by FirstSearch Technology Corporation. This report was completed in accordance with ASTM Practice E 1527-05. No sites of environmental concern were identified in the report.

As a result of the ESA performed on this site, the following recommendations should be considered during development and/or site preparation:

- 1. All miscellaneous containers should be removed from the site along with their contents and properly disposed of. Care should be taken to protect workers from potentially asbestos, lead, UFFI or other hazardous waste containing materials disturbed or encountered during site cleanup;
- 2. All debris should be removed from the site and properly disposed of;
- 3. All structures, structural remnants and their contents should be removed from the site and properly disposed of. Care should be taken to protect workers from potentially asbestos, lead, UFFI or other hazardous waste containing materials disturbed or encountered during demolition and/or removal of structures, structural remnants and their contents;

- 4. Any water supply wells and/or septic tanks discovered during site preparation should be properly abandoned per state and federal regulations and guidelines and;
- 5. Any petroleum contaminated soil should be collected and removed from the site per state and federal regulations and guidelines.

II. Introduction

Lewis Metty Development Company LLC requested from Mitchell Environmental P.A., the completion of a Phase I Environmental Assessment for the 162 acre site illustrated in Exhibit A. The site is located southeast of Jones Ferry Road, SR 1540 in Chatham County, NC.

The purpose of the ESA is to provide Lewis Metty Development with a comprehensive environmental evaluation of the property consistent with ASTM Practice E 1527-05 and that meets requirements of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (*CERCLA*) and the Superfund Authorization and Reauthorization Act (*SARA*).

The Scope of Services for this project included the following tasks:

- 1. Evaluation of reasonably ascertainable environmental database records and historical records,
- 2. Interviews with current and previous land owners and local emergency response personnel.
- 3. Site reconnaissance, and
- 4. Report preparation, including recommendations for additional investigations, if warranted.

III. Site Description

Two site evaluations were completed for this Phase I ESA Report. The first was conducted on March 5, 2007 and the second, including thorough perimeter evaluation, was conducted on May 8. The sky was clear during the site investigations. The site has been mostly cleared with some forest vegetation of varying ages left. The subject site disposes the majority of its storm water runoff into Meadow Branch and the rest to eastern and southern adjacent properties. Evaluation of historical aerial photos (1938, 1951, 1966, 1983) illustrate that the subject property was partially forested and cleared for farming during the 1930's but was abandoned from agriculture uses during the 50's and 60's.

IV. Records Review

An environmental database report for the property was supplied by FirstSearch Technology Corporation. This report was completed in accordance with ASTM Practice E 1527-05. No sites of environmental concern were identified in the report. The following databases and sources were researched:

The subject site does not appear on any list included in the database report.

The current USGS 7.5 minute topographical map (*Exhibit B*) confirmed the general site topography noted above. Additionally, the 4 years of historical aerial photos (1938, 1951, 1966, and 1983) that were reviewed as part of this ESA illustrate the historical uses of the subject properties.

V. Site Reconnaissance

Two site evaluations were conducted for this Phase I ESA Report (March 5 & May 8, 2007). The majority of the site has recently been thinned leaving some forest vegetation of varying ages covering most of the site. There are several piles of logged trees scattered throughout the property. One old logging path that begins below the southern property line and leads northeast to an old home site on the northwestern portion of the subject property, was observed during the site evaluation. Around the old home site are several piles of trash including glass, tires, etc. During the initial site visit, minimal debris was observed throughout the property. This debris included trash, and other debris typical of rural properties. According to the Bynum, NC, USGS topographical quadrangle map, the subject site disposes the majority of its storm water runoff into Meadow Branch and the rest to eastern and southern adjacent properties. This assessment has revealed no evidence of major recognized environmental conditions in connection with the subject property. Photographic documentation of this site reconnaissance is included in Appendix B.

VI. Interviews

As part of this ESA, Mr. Thad Bingham was interviewed on March 23, 2007. Mr. Bingham personally owned the lower 125 acre parcel for two years until recently selling it to Lewis Metty Development. Mr. Bingham's father owned the property beginning around the 1950's until ownership was given to his son. Mr. Bingham was not aware of any past, present or potential recognized environmental conditions on the subject property or adjacent properties. The combination of, the records review, site reconnaissance, and interviews with current and past property owners do not indicate any

major existing environmental conditions on the subject site. Previous owner of the north section of the site, Mr. Marvin Meecham, was not available for interview. In addition, North-Chatham Fire Chief, Mr. John Strowd, confirmed that no emergency response records were found relating to this site.

VII. Findings

Asbestos

No asbestos sampling was conducted on the subject site, however, there is a minute potential for asbestos within debris piles and structures on the site.

Hazardous Waste

No hazardous waste was observed on the subject site, however, there is a minute potential for hazardous materials within debris piles and structures on the site. Mr. Thomas Bender, the Chatham County Fire Marshal was contacted March 23, 2007. He was unaware of any hazardous spills at or near the subject site in the past 14 years.

Lead

No lead containing materials were observed on the subject site, however, there is a minute potential for lead containing materials within debris piles and structures on the site.

Pesticides / Herbicides

Pesticides or herbicides were observed on the site. However, there is a minute potential for pesticides or herbicides within debris piles and structures on the site.

Polychlorinated Biphenyls (*PCBs*)

No structures containing PCBs were observed on the subject site.

Radon

No radon testing was conducted on the site. The database report does lists a radon concentration of 0.3 PCI/L for this area.

Underground Storage Tanks (*USTs*)

No underground storage tanks were observed on site.

Above Ground Storage Tanks (*ASTs*)

No above ground storage tanks were observed on site.

Urea Formaldehyde Foam Insulation (*UFFI*)

No Urea Formaldehyde Foam Insulation sampling was conducted on the site, however, there is a minute potential for UFFI containing materials within debris piles and structures on the site.

Cedar Mountain Subdivision - Chatham County, NC

Waste Water

No wastewater concerns were observed on the subject site.

Electromagnetic Fields (EMFs)

No Electromagnetic Field testing was conducted on the subject properties. No potential sources of abnormally high EMFs were observed on or near the subject properties.

VIII. Conclusions

This assessment has revealed no evidence of major recognized environmental conditions on or near the subject site. As a result of the ESA performed on this site, the following recommendations should be considered during site development and/or demolition:

- All miscellaneous containers should be removed from the site along with their contents and properly disposed of. Care should be taken to protect workers from potentially asbestos, lead, UFFI or other hazardous waste containing materials disturbed or encountered during site cleanup;
- 2. All debris should be removed from the site and properly disposed of;
- 3. All structures, structural remnants and their contents should be removed from the site and properly disposed of. Care should be taken to protect workers from potentially asbestos, lead, UFFI or other hazardous waste containing materials disturbed or encountered during demolition and/or removal of structures, structural remnants and their contents;
- 4. Any water supply wells and/or septic tanks discovered during site preparation should be properly abandoned per state and federal regulations and guidelines and
- 5. Any petroleum contaminated soil should be collected and removed from the site per state and federal regulations and guidelines.





Receptors: *US DOC* SENSITIVE RECEPTORS - 2005 Census Bureau's TIGER (Topologically Integrated Geographic Encoding and Referencing System) database of schools and hospitals. List of schools and hospitals that may house individuals deemed sensitive to environmental discharges due to their fragile immune systems.

NPDES: *EPA* THE NATIONAL POLLUTION DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM - Database of permitted facilities receiving and discharging effluents to and from a natural source where treatment of the effluent is monitored.

FINDS: *EPA* FACILITY INDEX SYSTEM(FINDS)/FACILITY REGISTRY SYSTEM(FRS) - The index of identification numbers associated with a property or facility which the EPA has investigated or has been made aware of in conjunction with various regulatory programs. Each record indicates the EPA office that may have files on the site or facility. A Facility Registry System site has an FRS in the status field.

TRIS: *EPA* TOXIC RELEASE INVENTORY SYSTEM (TRIS)— Database that contains information on toxic chemical releases and other waste management activities reported annually by certain covered industry groups as well as federal facilities. This inventory was established under the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act of 1986 (EPCRA) and expanded by the Pollution Prevention Act of 1990.

HMIRS: *US DOT* HAZARDOUS MATERIALS INCIDENT RESPONSE SYSTEM - Database of information regarding materials, packaging, and a description of events for tracked incidents.

NCDB: *EPA* NATIONAL COMPLIANCE DATA BASE SYSTEM - Database of regional compliance and enforcement activity and manages the Pesticides and Toxic Substances Compliance and Enforcement program at a national level. The system tracks all compliance monitoring and enforcement activities from the time an inspector conducts and inspection until the time the inspector closes or the case settles the enforcement action. NCDB is the national repository of the 10 regional and Headquarters FIFRA/TSCA Tracking System (FTTS).

Data collected in the regional FTTS is transferred to NCDB to support the need for monitoring national performance of regional programs.

PADS: *EPA* DATABASE OF PCB HANDLERS - Database of PolyChlorinatedBiPhenol generators, transporters, storers and/or disposers that are required to register with the EPA. This database indicates the type of handler and registration number. Also included is the PCB Transformer Registration Database.

AIRS: *EPA* AEROMETRIC INFORMATION RETRIEVAL SYSTEM (AIRS) – database of detailed information pertaining to sites which submit air emissions reports. Developed under the Clean Air Act, this database also maintains data on compliance status and enforcement actions.

RADON: *NTIS* NATIONAL RADON DATABASE - EPA radon data from 1990-1991 national radon project collected for a variety of zip codes across the United States.

DOCKET: *EPA* INTERGRATED COMPLIANCE INFORMATION SYSTEM (ICIS) - database of federal administrative and federal judicial cases under the following environmental statutes: the Clean Air Act (CAA), the Clean Water Act (CWA), the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA) Section 313, the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA or Superfund), the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA), and the Marine Protection, Research, and Sanctuaries Act (MPRSA).

Nuclear Permits: *EPA/NRC* PERMITTED NUCLEAR FACILITIES - This database is a comprehensive listing of all facilities which have been issued permits for the handling of radioactive materials, in addition it also contains a complete listing of all licensed and active nuclear power plants located within the United States. THE RADINFO DATABASE - Database of basic information about facilities that are permitted and regulated for their use and handling of radioactive materials.



















