Attachment #1 Ordinance Establishing a Planning Board

Section 1. Appointment and Compensation

B. All appointments, except those necessary to fill an unexpired term, shall be for a term which expires on the date that the term of the appointing Commissioner expiresthat begins in January following the election of the appointing Commissioner and expires on the 31st day of the December following the expiration of the term of the appointing Commissioner. Appointments to fill an unexpired term shall be for the length of the unexpired term. No member shall serve more than two (2) consecutive terms without being off Planning Boardvacating Planning Board membership for a one (1) year waiting period. A member may serve an unexpired term and two (2) successive terms without a waiting period. Ex-officio members may from time to time be appointed by the Board of Commissioners to serve such terms as are fixed by the Appointing Resolution; however, ex-officio members shall not vote on matters before the Planning Board.

Section 2. Organization, Rules, Meeting, and Records

A. At its first meeting after the first Monday in December of each year, the Planning Board shall meet and elect a Chairman and a Vice Chairman and create and fill other offices as it may determine. The term of the Chairman and Vice Chairman shall be for one (1) year, with eligibility for reelection for one (1) additional term. The procedure for such elections shall be defined in the Chatham County Planning Board Rules of Procedure.
