

The Chatham County Appearance Commission met on Wednesday, October ⁸~~9~~, 2008 to review two projects.

The first project was the BellMeade Farm Cemetery, on 64W near the Solid Rock Baptist Church. The project was presented by Nick Robinson, Atty. and two of the owners, the Messrs. O'Neal. The CCAC was impressed by the choices and quantity of proposed landscaping. The lighting and parking, as presented, conformed with County Guidelines. The signage is proposed to be unobtrusive and in accordance with Ordinances. The CCAC did not feel a need to recommend any changes to the plans, as presented.

The second project, the Grill-n-Go in the Wilsonville area, was also represented by Nick Robinson, Atty. The owner, Alex Copeland, was present, as well as one of his partners, who is his brother-in-law. The CCAC approved of the plans as presented, seeing no need to make additional recommendations.
