Chatham County Board of Commissioners:

Re: Public Hearing on Polks Village (Continuation) - New Information

Commissioners:

My name is Rita Spina, Vice-President of Chatham Citizens for Effective Communities (CCEC). I live at 12 Matchwood, Pittsboro, N.C. As you are aware, CCEC pays attention to the status of various development projects. Tonight, I would like to call your attention to some mis-information that was provided to you at the September 20th hearing for Polks Village.

If you recall, Mr Luis Rocas, the representative of the Williams Corner developer, upon questioning by Commissioner Vanderbeck, indicated that the wastewater treatment permit for Williams Corner was valid.

The NPDES Permit for the construction of a wastewater treatment plant at Williams Corner was originally issued to Aqua North Carolina, Inc. under the name North Chatham Green Initiative, Permit No. WQ0030235. Please note this permit was for construction only and did not include provisions for any associated spray fields. On May 20, 2010 in a letter to the NC Department of Environment and Natural Resources and signed by Trent Parker, Area Manager for Aqua North Carolina, it was indicated that this plant was never constructed and that there were no future plans for construction.

On June 10, 2010 the Department of Environment and Natural Resources responded to Mr. Parker's letter and notified him that the NPDES reuse permit No. WQ0030235 was rescinded effective immediately and that any future operation of a non-discharge system would require a new application and permit.

Dear Mr. Parker:

Reference is made to your request for rescission of the subject Reuse Permit. Staff from the Raleigh Regional Office has confirmed that this Permit is no longer required. Therefore, in accordance with your request, Reuse Permit No. WQ0030235 is rescinded, effective immediately.

If in the future, you wish again to operate a non-discharge system, you must first apply for and receive a new Reuse Permit. Operating a non-discharge system without a valid Reuse Permit will subject the responsible party to a civil penalty of up to \$25,000 per day.


Dear Mr. Hardee:

Aqua North Carolina, Inc. (Aqua) received the above-referenced NOV on May 10, 2010, a copy of which is enclosed. Per our conversation, the wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) at North Chatham Green Initiative was never constructed and there are no future plans for construction of the WWTP.

Therefore, Aqua does not owe the annual administering and compliance fee in the amount of \$1,310.00 which was due on September 20, 2008. Please correct your records to indicate this WWTP will not be built and no annual fees should be invoiced to Aqua.
