The CCAC members approved the plans as presented, with the following recommendations: The proposed buffer planting on the Northeast boundary will consist of a mix of Wax Myrtle (Morella cerifera), Western Redcedar (Thuja plicata) also known as Arborvitae, and the developer's original choice of Japanese Cedar (Cryptomeria japonica). In the likely event that the septic repair area on the North and West boundary has to be timbered and put into service, CCAC recommends that a buffer of the same variety of evergreens as listed above be planted to replace the lost buffering on that boundary. As always, the developer is cautioned that plant material should be installed at a favorable time, not in the summer heat, and that monitoring of supplemental watering is critical for the success of the plant material. There was considerable discussion re: the condition of the original buffering which was installed several years ago when the conditional permit was issued. The developer was reminded that buffers must be maintained in a living, thriving condition.
