As for Sunset Grove, I see that they plan to make the cemetery part of a residential lot, rather than part of a common area like the last developer proposed. I talked to them awhile back and at that time they hadn't even seen the cemetery and did not know what their plans would be. I would like to get more details on their plan for protecting the cemetery. I think they should have a qualified person (archaeologist) mark the boundaries of the cemetery so they can insure that the lot line does not intersect it and that any other construction activities do not impact it. We believe there may be several unmarked graves at the site. An archaeologist should be able to indicate the boundaries of the cemetery so that all of the graves are within a protected area. The size of the cemetery might also be relevant to any determinations of usable lot size, etc.
