#### Lynn,

After talking with Mark Ashness, he ran the water model (model is calibrated off of existing flow conditions) after shifting the original design of the interconnection to the new location which is closer in proximity to the residents at the end of Valley Ln. (Phase III of Monterreane). The model showed we lose about 20-30 gpm during fire flow conditions (versus present interconnection location) due to elevation changes. In both cases the flows remained above minimum state design requirements. After reviewing these results in conjunction with the previous flow results from the design model it is clear that the looping of Sunset Grove's waterlines and keeping the interconnections at the same location is the best solution for not only Sunset Grove but also the residents of Valley Ln. (Monterreane). Water quality and system pressure will improve once the looped system is installed and operational. Let me know if you need anything else.

Just as a side note: Mr. Phil Ewing at 560 Valley Ln. came by earlier this week to discuss this particular situation with me and express his concerns.
