

## CHAPEL HILL EATERIES SPURN SIT-DOWNERS

CHAPEL HILL, Feb. 29.—Lunch counter sit-downs spread to the university community late today as Negro teen-agers vainly sought service in local eating establishments.

About 15 high school students went into the bus station grill and occupied the entire serving counter. Proprietor Leo Eliadis told them he would be glad to serve them in a separate section of his cafe, which is set up for Negro patrons.

After they declined to leave, Eliadis closed up his place. At a nearby drug store the soda fountain booths were roped off after the group was refused service there. A dairy bar in the same neighborhood closed up Sunday night after declining seated service to a number of Negro boys and girls.
