

Negro Student Fined After Racial Strife

COLUMBIA, March 7 (AP)—A Negro student from Allen University, arrested near the scene of an earlier racial disturbance, was convicted on a loafing and loitering charge today and fined \$10.50.

It was testified in Recorder's Court that 23-year-old Arnold M. Smith, the convicted student, was one of a band of about 30 dispersed near a drive-in restaurant early Sunday.

The drive-in was one scene of racial clashes Saturday.

Police Sgt. R. S. Younginer said Smith was armed with a one-by-two piece of lumber studded with a large nail.
