

# 45 Students To Be Tried In Sitdown

The trial of 45 A&T and Bennett College students on trespass charges is scheduled at 9:30 a.m. today in Municipal-County Court.

The group, composed of 43 Negroes and two white girls, is to appear before Judge Hampton Howerton Jr., in whose court William Vaden is solicitor.

They are accused of trespassing at the lunch counter of S. H. Kress and Co., 208 S. Elm St., on April 21 after the manager of the store had requested them not to seat themselves at the counter.

In court yesterday, Frank E. White, 40, Boston Negro, was given an active three-month term for drunkenness and carrying a razor concealed.

A one-year license revocation was recommended against John Herman Somers, 45, of Route 1, Reidsville, who also was fined \$100 and costs for driving intoxicated.

Ten persons were fined \$10 and costs for speeding in 20-mile school zones.
