

# Library Meeting Set At Danville

DANVILLE, May 25—A mass meeting of persons interested in avoiding integration of the Danville Public Library has been called for next Tuesday night at the City Armory.

C. S. Wheatle, attorney for steering committee of a group interested in establishing a foundation, said that the meeting is for the purpose of explaining how a private library would function.

A charter already has been applied for before the State Corporation Commission and is expected by the first of the week.

Both white and Negro libraries here are closed. Wheatley said that participation in the June 14 referendum on the library's future will be discussed Tuesday night.
