City Manager Geoff Dolan stated that the Revised Boards and Commissions Handbook has the changes which the City Council directed staff to make at the last City Council meeting; that there is no staff presentation; that staff is available to answer any questions; that the first Boards and Commissions Orientation is scheduled for Tuesday, June 10, 2008; and that while all Commissioners have been invited, it was identified to the new Commissioners that the Orientation is mandatory.

<u>05/20/08-16 Introduction of Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Proposed Operating Budget and the</u> <u>2008-2013 Capital Improvement Plan</u>

City Manager Geoff Dolan advised that this item includes the introduction of the proposed Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Operating Budget and 2008-2013 Capital Improvement Plan. He announced the upcoming Budget Study Session on Tuesday, May 27, 2008.

Finance Director Bruce Moe acknowledged the efforts of Finance Department Staff in compiling the proposed Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Operating Budget. He highlighted upcoming Budget meetings as follows: a Town Hall Meeting on May 21, 2008, 6:00 p.m. in the City Manager's Conference Room in City Hall; a Budget Study Session on May 27, 2008, at 5:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers; and a Public Hearing and adoption of the Budget at the June 3, 2008 City Council Meeting. With the aid of a PowerPoint presentation, Finance Director Moe provided an overview of the proposed 2008-2009 Budget. He offered input on the idea of increasing the transient occupancy tax (TOT) and clarified that the TOT is a general tax which can be allocated as directed by the Council. He advised that property tax revenues not previously budgeted were included in the 2008-2009 Budget to offset reductions in various revenues, and that Worker's Compensation increases were generally driven by the one-year salary continuation requirement for injured employees.

Finance Controller Henry Mitzner offered clarification concerning the Worker's Compensation calculations.

There was no public comment on this item.

City Manager Dolan verified that a five-year history of Worker's Compensation costs will be presented at the upcoming Budget Study Session on May 27, 2008. He also explained that cameras in sewer lines are required by both Federal and State Law, at a cost of approximately \$500,000.
