*04/23/09-2 Sepulveda Boulevard Corridor Parking Study – Evaluation of Existing and Potential Impacts*

PPIC conducted public a hearing and recommended to restrict parking near major intersections on Sepulveda; oppose prohibition of parking on Sepulveda with the exception of peak traffic times; initiate Neighborhood Traffic Plans for Oak Avenue from Rosecrans Avenue to Manhattan Beach Blvd and Dianthus Street between 1<sup>st</sup> Street and Duncan Avenue as first priorities; conduct a feasibility study to facilitate a BID or Association; explore options restricting access to Oak Avenue between Rosecrans Ave and Manhattan Beach Blvd.

*04/23/09-3 Review of Proposed 2009-2010 Capital Improvement Plan*

PPIC reviewed the item and supported the 2009-2010 Capital Improvement Plan as is with the following comments: a three year payback on any energy related item is preferred, and any extra CIP funds be spent on maintenance and upgrades to existing infrastructure (water, sewer, storm drains, and roads).
