The Manhattan Beach Chamber of Commerce completed another active year. Our finances are not doing as well as usual due the economy and to our cut from the City. We appreciate all that you have done for us and hope that we will be able to continue our work together.

Items of particular note completed during the year ending June 30, 2009 include:

- We have added about 173 new members in this fiscal year.
- Unfortunately we lost 200 members in this year due to the economy
- Retention by contacting members prior to the time the dues are due and checking with them about how they perceive the Chamber. This is done by our Ambassadors.
- We had a very successful WIB Conference, presenting eight \$2000 Scholarships,
 \$2500 to the Wellness Community and bringing it back to Manhattan Beach.

- We distributed more then 10,000 directories to our businesses and residents. Our entire directory will be on-line this year.
- We had a fun and profitable Business Expo on the site of the Farmer's Market.
 Thank you to the City for all the help with this great project.
- Our Economic Development Committee is publishing another beautiful calendar at no charge. This will be distributed through the Home Town Faire, the Farmers Market and the Manhattan Beach Chamber Office.
- We have contributed to the Ocean Express; again bring visitors to Manhattan Beach.
- We have built a productive, efficient, hard working and congenial Office
 Environment and Staff that supports, takes reservations, implements and attend
 about 50 events each year. I personally attend most chamber meetings and events
 as well as community and regional programs on behalf of the chamber.
- We hosted our annual Mayor's Breakfast that keeps our citizens aware of what is happening in Manhattan Beach.

- We had five of our members attended the California Chamber Legislative Conference in Sacramento along with several other members of Legislative Advocacy Council.
- David Curry, Mayor Portia Cohen and I went to Access DC and met with many of our legislators.
- I am on the Board for the South Bay Medal of Valor.
- The Manhattan Beach Chamber has become well respected and looked up to by not only our members but by other chambers-local, state and U.S.
- I have been asked to assist other chambers grow and advise on success strategies.
- We contributed to the Holiday Fireworks
- We had the Holiday lights up in a timely manner and in good condition under a new contract. This year we are having all the Holiday lights refurbished and will use energy saving lights
- Our Young Professionals group (MBYP) continues to grow and bring in new members to our Chamber.
- We added several benefits for our members
 - Ben-e-Lect which helps small business buy reasonably priced Health Care Insurance
 - o Our members are eligible to be members of Kinecta Federal Credit Union
 - O Probrowse.com offers our members free websites and the opportunity to send out special offers. They are also helping us do away with our ChamberPak which will save us printing and mailing costs. Our members will still be able to get out their flyers but it will be on line and help us go green.

We are pleased with the accomplishments and outreach achieved during this year. Our Legislative Council now meets at AdventurePlex, our Women in Business is already in the planning stage for the next WIB Conference and now have bi-monthly events that offer speakers that provide information for our members, the Ambassadors are doing a great job with making our new members feel welcome and keeping our veteran members happy and informed.

There is no way we could do any of these things without the help of the City.
