SUBJECT: Adopt Resolution No. 6247 Adopting a Revised Bail Schedule For Violations of the Manhattan Beach Municipal Code.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt Resolution No. 6247 adopting a revised bail schedule for violations of the Manhattan Beach Municipal Code.

FISCAL IMPLICATION:

While only a small percentage of revenue from bail is received by the City (the bulk of the funds go to the Court system) the Courts do look to the City's bail schedule in determining the appropriate amount of "city costs" which are often paid through plea bargains in lieu of fines. Since all of these funds go to the City and current revenues from "City costs" average about \$50,000 per year we can expect some modest increase in revenue from the proposed increase in bail amounts. Money from Municipal Code prosecutions goes into the City's general fund.

BACKGROUND:

The current bail schedule was last amended in March of 2003 and prior to that in 1996. Since the last amendment a number of new code sections creating new violations have been added to the Municipal Code. These are not covered by the existing bail schedule and if an individual were taken into custody for violation of one of these sections the courts would refuse to set bail. In addition the proposed bail schedule increases existing bail amounts by an average of 20%.

DISCUSSION:

The bail schedule is used when an individual is cited for a municipal code violation and is unable to provide sufficient identification to ensure that they can be located if they fail to appear in court. The schedule is also used by judges when they issue bench warrants for those who fail to make mandatory court appearances for municipal code violations. The current bail schedule specifies amounts which are low enough that the forfeiture of the bail amount is not an effective disincentive for non-appearance. In addition the current bail schedule does not provide bail amounts for some municipal code violations. The proposed revised bail schedule increases the bail amounts currently in use (\$50-\$100 for infractions and \$250-\$500 for misdemeanors) 20% across the board to reflect the increase in the cost of living over the last seven years. Additional violations were added to the schedule to reflect the current code and remedy omissions on the current schedule. The Police

Department has reviewed the schedule and their comments have been incorporated in the proposed schedule.

Should the Council approve Resolution 6247 the revised schedule will be submitted to the Superior Court and must be approved not only by all judges in the Southwest District (where our cases are heard) but by the Los Angeles County Judge's Association Bail Committee and thereafter all Los Angeles county Judges before becoming effective. (Government Code section 72621; Penal Code section 1269b(d).)

RESOLUTION NO. 6247

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING A REVISED BAIL SCHEDULE FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the United States and California Constitutions provide that the opportunity for bail be provided to arrestee unless the arrestee is highly likely to flee the jurisdiction of the Court; and

WHEREAS, revision of the Manhattan Beach Municipal Code's Bail Schedule is necessary in order to reflect recent revisions of the Code; and

WHEREAS, under existing law, Municipal Ordinances are enforced through the Superior Courts, by issuing a citation to appear in Court to the alleged violator, or by the City Prosecutor's filing a criminal complaint in Court against the alleged violator; and

WHEREAS, classifying particular violations of the Manhattan Beach Municipal Code as infractions for the purpose of the Bail Schedule only, for those filed citations issued pursuant to Penal Code Section 853.6, is desirable in order to lessen the burden on the Court system and to promote ease of resolution of Municipal Code violations;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, ORDER AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby repeals the existing Bail Schedule on file with the Superior Court and adopts the revised Bail Schedule set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. By this resolution, the City of Manhattan Beach requests that the judges of the Superior Court for the County of Los Angeles approve the establishment, increase, and reduction, where appropriate, of bail for violations of the Manhattan Municipal Code as set forth in the Bail Schedule.

SECTION 3. The Manhattan Beach Municipal Code designates that certain offenses thereof shall be misdemeanors. Certain of these offenses are designated as infractions for purposes of the Bail Schedule only. The designation of certain misdemeanors as infractions on the Bail Schedule applies only to violations set forth on a Notice to Appear citation form, issued pursuant to Penal Code Section 853.6. The designation of offenses and the bail contained in the Bail Schedule does not apply to formal criminal complaints filed by the City Prosecutor pursuant to Penal Code Sections 740 and 949. That is, notwithstanding the designations contained in the Bail Schedule, the City Prosecutor may initiate criminal prosecution by a formal complaint and charge the defendant with misdemeanor violations pursuant to the Municipal Code designation.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately, except for the provision which repeals the existing Bail Schedule. Resolution 5798 is hereby rescinded in its entirety and replaced by this Resolution. The existing Bail Schedule shall not be repealed and replaced with the revised Bail Schedule until the latter is approved by all required Courts and becomes effective in the Los Angeles County Superior Court.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution; shall cause the same to be entered among the original resolutions of said City; shall make a minute of the passage and adoption thereof in the records of the proceedings of the City Council of said City in the minutes of the meeting at which the same is passed and adopted; and shall transmit this Resolution and Bail Schedule to the South Bay Superior Court.
