Chief Ferguson began his Fire career in 1984 with the City of Vancouver, WHEREAS, Washington. In 2002 he became an Assistant Fire Chief with the Peoria Fire Department in Arizona, and in 2008, was selected as the Fire Chief for the City

of Manhattan Beach; and

Chief Ferguson earned his Bachelor of Liberal Studies Degree in 2002 from WHEREAS. Eastern Oregon University; earned a Masters Degree in Psychology from Wayland

Baptist University; and holds an Executive Fire Officer Certificate from the

National Fire Academy in Maryland; and

during his tenure as Fire Chief of Manhattan Beach, he led the Department WHEREAS, through a 9 month long staffing study and most recently initiated a strategic

plan for future initiatives and improved service delivery to the community; and

Chief Ferguson was instrumental in organizing the first "Fire Muster" whereby WHEREAS, City staff, media personnel and elected officials were able to experience and

perform numerous firefighting skills and evolutions; and

Chief Ferguson has been a member of the Manhattan Beach Rotary since 2008 WHEREAS.

and is also a member of various Fire Chief Boards and organizations; and

during his tenure with the City of Manhattan Beach, Chief Ferguson has dedicated WHEREAS. himself to improving the Fire Department and to serving the community. He was committed to the development of his personnel and to the highest level of Fire

Department services possible. Chief Ferguson has been described as "A Rising Star in the Fire Service" and has earned the respect of his employees, his fellow

Fire Service professionals and our community.
