PPIC conducted a public meeting and approved staff recommendation to post “No Parking Anytime” restrictions on four segments on the west side of Sepulveda Boulevard. This decision will be reviewed by the City Council at a future meeting. Additionally, the commission requested that staff be directed to conduct a follow-up study to be brought back to the commission for review, and to work with the business at 2609 Sepulveda Boulevard to find additional parking.
