SUBJECT: Introduction of Fiscal Year 2010-2011 Proposed Operating Budget

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that the City Council accept the presentation of the Fiscal Year 2010-2011 Proposed Operating Budget.

## **FISCAL IMPLICATION:**

The FY 2010-2011 General Fund budget reflects a deficit \$2,046,536. Available unallocated money in the General Fund is available to cover the deficit without the use of reserves. Additionally, we have several options for the City Council to consider that, if adopted, will further reduce the deficit.

## **DISCUSSION:**

Staff is pleased to present the proposed operating budget for Fiscal Year 2010-2011. The budget is the culmination of several months of work on the part of all departments as well as Finance staff.

As in past years, the budget document presents detailed information about each department's operations, service indicators, goals and accomplishments, staffing levels, funding sources and proposed expenditures. This document also includes capital improvement projects proposed for approval and appropriation within the FY 2010-2011 budget year.

Tonight we will be presenting an overview of the major components of the budget. This will be followed by several Council study sessions and opportunities for public input. The calendar of events is as follows:
