SUBJECT: Consideration of Ratifying the Appointment of a Mira Costa High School Student to the Parks & Recreation Commission Seat No. 7

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff is recommending that the City Council appoint Levi Schoenfeld to Seat No. 7 on the Parks & Recreations Commission for a term of one year.

FISCAL IMPLICATION:

There are no fiscal implications associated with the recommended action

DISCUSSION:

The Parks and Recreation Commission consists of seven (7) members and has responsibility for the play and recreational needs of all residents. Specifically, the Commission consists of four (4) Citizen-at-Large members, one (1) Older Adult representative, one (1) nominated by the Manhattan Beach Unified School Board and one (1) Mira Costa High School (MCHS) student.

The MCHS student (Seat No. 7) on the Parks and Recreation Commission is nominated by MCHS. The student representative serves a one-year term, therefore, the current MCHS representative, Jennifer Rosenthal, is not eligible for reappointment. The City Clerk's Office has received notification that MCHS has nominated Levi Schoenfeld to fill Seat No. 7.

Staff is recommending that the City Council appoint Levi Schoenfeld to Seat No. 7 for a one-year term.
