## V. <u>GENERAL BUSINESS</u>

01/0612.3 Architectural Bench Prototypes

The Strand Alcove Bench project contracted four architects and they were contacted regarding the price of the designs they submitted and were asked if they would underwrite the manufacturing cost of the prototypes. The architects responded by offering a with a 20-25% discount off the price point but due to the economic down trend they are unable to take on the entire manufacturing cost. Commissioner De Maria plans to continue the conversation with the architects.

The Commission discussed the Veteran's Memorial Parkway as a temporary installation site. The Commission is interested in recouping the cost of the bench prototypes and one option is that they approach local businesses to see if they are interested in purchasing one of the benches. A second option involves leasing the prototypes to some of the art collectors or corporate entities in Manhattan Beach.

The Commission asked that the architects be reminded that muted tones be used for the bench designs.

Modifications to the architectural bench designs are as follows:

- 1. Predock\_Frane change the anatomical forms so they appear abstract; (\$14,000)
- 2. CK Architecture Shell and Whale designs can be combined on one board with the Shell highlighted to scale with a clear distinction between rendered design materials for each; (Shell 18,000; Whale \$23,000)
- 3. Sparano+Mooney AXO Structure needs to be reconfigured (\$14,759)
- 4. Ball Nogues Studio select one bench and change color to a muted tone

Commissioner De Maria will contact the architects and report back at the next meeting.
