SUBJECT: Consideration of the Re-Appointment of Doug Herbst to the South Bay Workforce Investment Board

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council re-appoint Doug Herbst to serve as a Manhattan Beach representative to the South Bay Workforce Investment Board (SBWIB) for the term of office of July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2015.

FISCAL IMPLICATION:

There is no fiscal implication associated with the recommended action.

DISCUSSION:

The SBWIB administers and delivers services pursuant to the Federal Job Training Partnership Act to the residents of Carson, El Segundo, Gardena, Hawthorne, Hermosa Beach, Inglewood, Lawndale, Manhattan Beach, and Redondo Beach. Manhattan Beach has had two representatives on the board since February 2000.

One of the Manhattan Beach SBWIB seats is currently held by, Tom Beedon, the General Manager of the Belamar Hotel, for the term of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2013.

Doug Herbst, with Heaven & Earth Productions, was nominated by the Board of Directors of the Manhattan Beach Chamber of Commerce and appointed by the Manhattan Beach City Council in 2010 to serve the remainder of the other SBWIB seat for Manhattan Beach. His current term ends June 30, 2011.

If the City Council approves the Chamber of Commerce request to re-appoint Doug Herbst to the SBWIB, the appointment will be presented to the City of Hawthorne City Council for ratification. The City of Hawthorne is designated as the agency responsible for administering the SBWIB.
