**SUBJECT:** Approve Plans and Specifications for the 2011-2012 Water Main Replacement

Project Phase 1 in Various Streets in the Sand Section and Authorize the City

Manager to Solicit Construction Bids

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that City Council approve plans and specifications for the 2011-2012 Water Main Replacement Project Phase 1 and authorize the City Manager to solicit construction bids.

#### **FISCAL IMPLICATION:**

Water Funds in the amount of \$2,200,000 were appropriated by City Council for this project through the fiscal year 2010-2011 and 2011-2012 Capital Improvement Plan. The project was broken into two phases for design and construction with \$1,474,000 allocated to Phase 1.

A breakdown of revenues and anticipated expenditures is presented on the following table.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

This project is part of the City's annual water main replacement program. This program replaces old and/or undersized water mains. These main replacements will reduce the risk of main breaks and will enhance water flow for domestic consumption and fire suppression..

On February 15, 2011, City Council awarded a professional services agreement to Willdam for design services for the fiscal year 2011-2012 Water Main Replacement Project (Phase 1) for \$83,360 and approved a contract amendment extending the term of the existing as-needed professional services agreement with Willdam Engineering to June 30, 2012. The plans and specifications for the project are now significantly complete.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

As part of the fiscal year 2011-2012 Water Main Replacement Project – Phase 1, new 6" diameter ductile iron pipe shall replace existing water mains in the following streets:
