RE: Sewer Main Line Extension - Overlook

The administration has received a request from the owners of Lot 2, Block 3, Overlook Business Park, to extend the sewer main line from Matanuska Road about 150 feet along a utility easement so that they may connect to the system. If this project were constructed by the City it appears to be reasonable to continue the line to Industrial Way so others may connect at a later date.

The engineer estimates the cost of the requested extension to be about \$20,000. Continuing the project to Industrial Way may add about \$10,000 to the project.

Administration recommends that Council authorize the allocation of up to \$30,000 from Municipal Grant No. 4/87-475 for a sewer main line extension in Overlook Business Park.

Overlook Sewer Extension Preliminary Estimate
Work Order No. G90-02

Dear Bob:

We have completed our preliminary cost estimate for a sewer service main extension into Block 3, Overlook Business Park as described in Work Order No. G90-02 dated March 2, 1990.

This project consists of 150 lineal feet of three (3)-inch sewer service lateral beginning at a point along the Old Matanuska Road and going northwest along a utility easement, located between Lots 1,2,3 and 4, Block 3, Overlook Business Park. This cost estimate reflects those costs which are generally associated with underground construction. I have also included a utility relocation and easement acquisition estimate to give you some idea of the costs.

This preliminary estimate includes the costs associated with engineering design, construction, contract administration and city administration. The construction costs are based on public projects in which the minimum rates of pay were defined by the State of Alaska, Department of Labor.

I have not included the costs required to extend the sewer service to Industrial Way by your direction. However, I still believe that if the City plans to proceed with this project and obtain the necessary easements to install the service within the utility easement, it makes sense to continue this project 278 lineal feet through this easement and out into a public road; Industrial Way. This extension would give the City the ability to pick-up one and possibly three other sewer users.

It should be understood that the above estimate is to be used for budget planning purposes. Therefore, we recommend that the requested funding be between \$19,000 and \$22,000. Please call me if you have any questions.
