RE: Paving Projects

Council requested a summary of paving projects and the funding that may be made available this coming summer.

Projects under discussion:

Council has been provided a packet of information on the proposed projects and Local Improvement Districts.

Nelson Avenue and Glenwood Avenue may be considered as collector streets for which the City code provides that 2/3 of the project cost will be paid by the City. In conformance with City code, the project funding could be as follows:

The above funding format leaves a total of \$107,269 in the municipal grant and the \$30,000 designated for Nelson Avenue as uncommitted. Council earlier may have made a tentative commitment to fund 2/3 of the Naomi project, or about \$143,000. Such an action would not leave enough funds to pay the City's 66% on the other two projects from the municipal grant.

Without some subsidy to lower the per lot costs, it is doubtful that either the Shadowood or the Naomi project will pass muster. However, if Council subsidizes residential paving projects, future requests for subsidy can be expected from other subdivisions.

If Council wishes to proceed on any of the three projects they should provide direction on the amount of funds, if any, to be allocated to each project and to adopt the corresponding resolutions that direct a survey (vote) on the L.I.D.:

> Resolution WR92-19 - Naomi Resolution WR92-21 - Glenwood Resolution WR92-15 - Shadowood

The resolutions set the date for public hearing and vote tally for the three (3) districts to be on Wednesday, May 27, 1992. Council may wish to set different dates.
