# **COUNCIL MEMORANDUM NO. 93-29**

Subject: Beer at Ballfields

On June 8, 1992, Council considered a proposal from Ted and Marilyn Anderson (President of Mat-Su Softball Association and owners of the Mug Shot Saloon) to permit them to sell beer and wine at Bumpus Ballfields in cooperation with the softball association. A portion of the revenue was to go to the association through concession use fees with 2% (now sales tax) to go directly to the City. The Mug Shot would also sponsor tournaments. Council approved the concept without opposition.

Mr. and Mrs. Anderson didn't operate at Bumpus Ballfields in 1992. We have just beceived the Anderson's application for a catering beer and wine license. Staff wishes to advise Council that we expect the association and the Andersons to request use of the Bumpus concession stand for beer and wine sales this summer. These sales would occur only during adult association games.

Staff will work out a specific agreement with the Andersons and softball association to include restrictions on times of sale, storage of stock, clean up and liability insurance.

We ask that Council confirm its approval of beer and wine sales at Bumpus Ballfields and approve our non-objection to the Anderson beer and wine catering liquor license.

Mr. Ted Anderson, stated they expect to have the concession for the entire season, the Mat-Su Softball Association will pay for a maintenance crew to clean up and haul garbage. Mr. Anderson stated that he considered getting the catering license off the Mug Shot Saloon liquor license to sell beer and wine at the fields, they pay the Association to be in the concession stand and sponsor tournaments, and he would consider giving the City a similar amount to the sales tax paid in Palmer.

Motion/Second: Erickson/Carson

That Council approve the concept of selling beer and wine at the Bumpus Ballfields with the provision that the caterer give a 2% return on sales to the City. Motion passed.

F. <u>CM. No. 92-57</u>; Polarconsult E & O Insurance Mr. Deuser gave a brief background of events, stated that Polarconsult is owned by a Denmark Company, Bigum and Steenfos which is insured by a Swiss Company, Winterthur. If disputes occur they will be resolved in a Danish Court by Danish law. Mr. Deuser gave 4 alternatives as follows, but suggested Council not consider alternative 1 or 3. Mr. Deuser stated that he and Administration is looking for guidance from Council.

Alternative #1: Agree that it was a mutual mistake as to the nature of coverage requirements and start over.

<u>Alternative #2</u>: Resolve the questions as best as possible and accept the risk of coverage disputes and accept Polarconsult insurance.

<u>Alternative #3</u>: Make a determination of non-responsiveness and go to the second bidder.

Council indicated they may consider revising the present policy of not permitting alcoholic beverage sales at the concession stand at the Bumpus Ballfield Complex. The policy was established, at least in part, as a result of staff concerns that the concessionaire for the Mat-Su Softball Association did not have liquor liability insurance for the site. The concessionaire, Ted Anderson, has now informed us that the insurance is available if Council will permit the sale of beer as is done at the softball complex in Palmer.

Mr. Ted Anderson wishes to obtain City permission to sell beer/wine at the Bumpus Ballfields and will be available to respond to questions.

The purpose of this letter is to confirm to vou that the City of Wasilla agrees to continue the arrangement made last year between the City and the Mat-Su Softball Association, Inc. (MSSBA). On Friday, June 7, 1991, I met with Jeanie Borgford, President of the Mat-Su Softball Association.

To solve the dilemma of insurance coverage and the sale of alcohol by concessionaires under a written lease, the Mayor set out the following conditions for an informal agreement. The conditions were recommended by Deputy Administrator Bob Harris after his conversations with City of Valdez officials.

Informal Agreement - Mat-Su Softball Association

- (1) No written lease will be required.
- (2) MSSBA will maintain City as additional named insured as evidenced by certificate submitted for activities related to their use.
- (3) City will maintain liability insurance for public use of fields.
- (4) NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES will be permitted in the Bumpus Ballfield Complex.
- (5) MSSBA and City will share maintenance with City providing basic turf and facility maintenance and Association performing other work.
- (6) MSSBA has priority use of the fields and will maintain a use schedule.
- (7) The public may use the fields during non-scheduled times.

#### CONCESSIONAIRE PERMIT

The City of Wasilla grants to:

Theodore W. (Jr.) and Marilyn D. Anderson, D/B/A Mug Shot Saloon and Scenicware Alaska 251 West Parks Highway

Wasilla, Alaska 99654, hereinafter referred to as the Permittee:

This permit to operate a concession at the Bumpus Ballfield Complex subject to the conditions set forth below.

- (a) The City of Wasilla shall be provided a certificate of insurance issued to the Permittee which includes \$1,000,000 liquor liability for the Bumpus Ballfield site and names the City of Wasilla as an additional insured party.
- (b) Alcoholic beverages (beer and wine) may be sold only from one hour prior until one hour following the actual playing of ball games sponsored by the Mat-Su Softball Association and played by teams consisting primarily of adults over the age of 21 years. No sales of alcoholic beverages are permitted during play by teams consisting primarily of persons under age 21, or played by teams not sanctioned by the Mat-Su Softball Association.
- (c) The permittee, in coordination with the Mat-Su Softball Association, shall be responsible to maintain the cleanliness of the concession booth to standards acceptable to the Department of Environmental Conservation and the City of Wasilla.
- (d) The permittee, in coordination with the Mat-Su Softball Association, agrees to pick up and dispose of trash and used containers that are left in the softball field complex.
- (e) In the event that permittee elects not to provide concession services for activities not sponsored by the Mat-Su Softball Association, the City reserves the right to permit other organizations to operate the concession area for their activities.
- (f) The permittee shall pay to the City a permit fee for each day the concession stand is operated by the permittee. The fee is an amount equal to two percent (2%) of the gross revenue of all sales made during each day in which the concession is operated and shall be delivered to the City by the 2nd working day of each month following a month in which sales were made..
- (g) This permit is effective upon presentation of the above mentioned insurance certificate, and signatures of acknowledgement by the permittee and City official. The permit expires on December 1, 1992 unless sooner revoked at the sole discretion of the City.
