Police Officer Selection Process

As you are aware, the Wasilla Police Department has been involved over the last two months in the hiring process for police officers. This process has involved accepting 189 applications; conducting testing which included multiple choice and essay portions; oral boards; interviews; extensive background investigations which included interviews with present and past employers, spouses, exspouses, family, and work associates; psychological testing (written and interview); and polygraph testing. As a result, I am pleased to report we have recruited some excellent candidates for our police officer positions.

Attached you will find a brief personal and work history on each applicant who has been selected for hire. Offers of employment starting June 16, 1993 will be made to the final eight applicants pending the outcome of mandatory drug testing.
