The Administration respectfully requests that Council authorize the delay of assumption of permitting powers. In the motion to approve Ordinance 93-57 (Substitute), Council directed the Planning Office to take over planning powers effective July 1, 1994. As you are aware, the Planner has just now been hired and will begin work June 6.

Considering the long delay in getting the office established, we ask that the assumption of permitting duties be delayed 6 months until December 1, 1994. This will allow Mr. Dvorak to get his office up and running and work with Borough officials to assure a smooth and responsible transition of responsibility.
