Subject: Street Name Change (Confirmation) to Lake Lucille Lane from Hallea Drive

Owners of property served by the street now identified as Hallea Lane have asked that the City change or confirm that its official name be Lucille Lane. There has been on-going controversy over this name involving Charles Nevada, Jack Flint and Felix Bruno and others. Property owners requesting that the name be changed to Lucille Lane are Mr. Flint, Mr. Bruno and Mr. Shibalski, owner of the Lake Lucille Inn.

The street has been known as Lake Street, Lucille Lane and Hallea Lane.

Administration respectfully requests that Council initiate a name change (confirmation) action declaring that the street which extends south from the Parks Highway near the Section 8 and 9 section line and ends at Lake Lucille Drive be named Lucille Lane. A public hearing will be scheduled before the Planning and Utilities Commission on Tuesday, July 11, 1994. The Commission will forward a recommendation to Council at your July 25, 1994 meeting. On July 25, the Council would consider a formal resolution changing the name.
