Subject: Application for Residential Sewer Connection Assistance
(Combination Loan/Grant) Program

The City has received an application for sewer connection assistance from a senior citizen owner and near future occupant (Ms. Virginia M. Gaylen) of a residence to be relocated to Lots 28 & 29, Century Park Subdivision.

This residential assistance application does not appear to qualify for participation in the Program as it currently exists (October 10, 1988).


However, the proposed occupational activity is occurring after the qualifying date for original sewer hook-up assistance, and, the sewer system is available for connections.

Our average daily flow is currently below the DEC permit flow limits. We fully expect that the possibility of this connection will only serve to make the system more efficient and will certainly not exceed the permit limitations.

The City has adequate funds remaining (\$30,000) in the Sewer Assistance Program.

If approved, by waiver of existing requirements, this application would then qualify as a Class I, Residential Assistance Grant, with 50% of eligible costs paid as a Grant by the City not to exceed \$8,000 (\$4,000 for outright grant and \$4,000 loan).

Recommendation: Council approval, by waiver, for a Class I, Residential Assistance Grant, to assist Ms. Virginia M. Gaylen in hooking up to the City sewer system, with 50% of eligible costs paid as a Grant by the City not to exceed \$8,000 (\$4,000 for outright grant and \$4,000 loan).
