The City has received a petition from the owners of 13 lots adjacent to Winter Avenue requesting that a survey be taken on the question of forming a Local Improvement District (LID) for reconstruction and paving.

There are a total of 25 lots adjacent to Winter Avenue that would be included in the proposed assessment district.

All lots are essentially rectangular in shape with some arranged in perpendicular axis to the street while the others are arranged This makes for a variation of front footages.

Other connecting streets will be effected by the formation of this LID, mainly: Pinehurst, Gambit, and Snowflake Circles (cul-desacs), and portions of Holiday Drive and Poppy Lane.

Numerous residents on the connecting streets have also inquired as to the potential for a paving project and/or being included in an LID underway.

Recommendation: (1) Council approval for Administration to obtain an engineered cost estimate for the reconstruction and paving of Winter Drive and conduct a formal survey based on a per lot basis assessment.

(2) Council approval for Administration Recommendation: investigate the potential for including the other connecting streets (Pinehurst, Gambit, and Snowflake Circles (culde-sacs), and portions of Holiday Drive and Poppy Lane) in this LID project for "economy of scale" benefits.
