Anchorage

Cash: \$5,000

In Kind Services: \$32,000 + -

(Snow removal, Anchorage Police Department, Signs and Promotions, Permitted R-O-W, Public Works equipment and workers).

Nome

Cash: \$25,000

In Kind Services: \$50,000 + -

(Public Works equipment and workers, Snow removal, construction of new shoot with pipes)

Use of Convention Center for 30 days @ \$100 per day.

Use of a Banquet Building for 2 days @ \$450 per day.

In addition, the City built a new fence along main street, maintain a restricted one block holding area for the dogs, annual maintenance of the monument. The City of Nome also has major repair and replacement costs due to heavy usage of their buildings.
