Subject:

Airplane Assessment Limitation

As you will recall the Mat-Su Borough acted to limit property tax valuation of aircraft to \$5,000. A Wasilla aircraft owner inquired about the city's current policy. To date the City has not changed its policy on assessed values and would tax on the full value of an airplane, boat, truck camper shell or unlicensed off road vehicle (O.R.V.).

The City has these options:

- 1) No change charge our property tax mill levy (2.0 mills as an example) on the full value of an airplane, boat, camper shell or O.R.V.
- 2) Amend our code by ordinance to follow the borough's new policy to limit assessments of aircraft, boats and camper shells to \$5,000/each and to exempt unlicensed O. R.V.'s.
- 3) Do something else.

According to the borough assessor in 1994 in Wasilla there were:

72 Aircraft assessed at

1,700,000 or about 25,000 each

126 Boats assessed at

348,000 or about 2,800 each

49 Camper shells assessed at

46,000 or about 1,000 each

84 O.R.V. assessed at

171,000 or about 2,100 each

Total assessed value 1994

\$2,265,000

Tax revenue for the City 2.0 mill levy only is estimated as follows:

Option 1 (no change) $.002 \times \$2,265,000 = \$4530/\text{year}$ City tax revenue Option 2 (MSB limits) $.002 \times \$400,000 = \$800/\text{year}$ City tax revenue

Revenue loss to City with Option 2 <\$3730/year>

The impact on owners taxes paid would be as follows:

Aircraft 25,000 x .002 =

\$50.00 present tax

Option 2: $5000 \times .002 =$

10.00 new tax

\$40.00 savings

Boat 2,800 x .002 =

\$5.60 present tax

Option 2: less than \$5000

<u>no tax</u>

\$5.60 savings

Camper Shell $1000 \times .002 = 2.00$ present tax

Option 2: less than \$5000 = no tax

\$2.00 savings

O.R.V. \$2100 x .002 =

\$4.20 present tax

Option 2: exempt =

no tax

\$4.20 savings

There has been an extended public debate on this issue at the borough level. The assembly compromised at \$5,000 limitation and exemption of O.R.V.'s. For consistency I recommend that no third choice be considered for Wasilla.

Council is respectfully asked to consider this issue. Should it choose to offer this tax limitation it may do so by introducing Ordinance <u>95-18</u> for public hearing April 10, 1995.

CODE ORDINANCE

INTRODUCED BY: Borough Manager

MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 94-085 (SUB1)(AM)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY PARTIALLY EXEMPTING CERTAIN CLASSIFICATIONS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY.

BE IT ENACTED:

- * Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This ordinance is of a general nature and shall become part of the borough code.
 - * Section 2. <u>Amendment</u>. MSB 3.15.035 is amended to add the following:

Chapter 3.15

ASSESSMENT AND TAXATION

3.15.035 Optional exemptions.

- (C) The borough assessor shall:
- (1) classify boats and vessels for the purposes of taxation and may establish the assessed valuation of boats on the basis of their registered or certified net tonnage;
- (2) classify as to type and exempt or partially exempt any or all types of aircraft from taxation;
- (3) exempt or partially exempt from taxation all boats and vessels that are not documented under the laws of the United States:
 - (4) exempt or partially exempt from taxation all pickup campers, shells and canopies;
- (5) exempt from taxation all unlicensed motorized all-terrain vehicles, snow machines and trail bikes.
- (D) Personal property within the following classifications with tax situs within the borough is subject to the following exemption.
 - (1) Any aircraft value that exceeds a value of \$5,000.
 - (2) Any documented or undocumented vessel value that exceeds a value of \$5,000.
 - (3) Any pickup camper, shell or canopy value that exceeds a value of \$5,000.
