Subject: Vacation of a Portion of Discovery Drive Right-of-Way; review of the Mat-Su

Borough Platting Board's decision to approve with conditions.

The Wasilla City Council has 30 days from the date the vacation was approved by the Mat-Su Borough Platting Board to veto the approval. The approval of the platting board was granted on December 28, 1995. If the City Council takes no action by January 28, 1996, the request is automatically approved under provisions of Title 29, Alaska Statutes. If the Council specifically affirms the approval, the remainder of the review period is waived and the applicants can begin developing a plat for filing with the State Recorder's Office, in order to complete the vacation.

The Wasilla Planning Commission voted to forward the approved vacation of a portion of the Discovery Drive right-of-way to the Wasilla City Council for its consideration. The Commission recommends that the approval, with conditions, be upheld by a motion of the Council so that the affected property owners can complete the vacation process. This recommendation is based on a finding by the Commission that vacating a portion of Discovery Drive Right-of-Way will not affect the ability of the City or other public and private utilities to provide services to the public in an efficient and cost-effective manner.

Staff recommends that the Council follow the Commission's recommendation and affirm the decision of Mat-Su Borough Platting Board in its entirety.

# WASILLA PLANNING COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 96-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA PLANNING COMMISSION, RECOMMENDING APPROVAL BY THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL OF A VACATION OF DISCOVERY DRIVE RIGHT-OF-WAY, WITH CONDITIONS, AS APPROVED BY THE MAT-SU BOROUGH PLATTING BOARD.

WHEREAS, the Mat-Su Borough Platting Board has reviewed and approved the vacation of a portion of the Discovery Drive right-of-way, with conditions; and,

WHEREAS, City staff was notified of the proposed vacation by the Mat-Su Borough, prior to the decision by the platting board; and no detrimental impact was preceived by staff as a result of this action; and,

WHEREAS, the vacation of a right-of-way dedicated to the City is like a disposal of interest in City land and should only be allowed when it is determined to be in the best interest of the public; and,

WHEREAS, it appears that the vacation, as approved by the platting board, will not affect the ability of the City, Borough, or any public or private utility from providing services to the public in an efficient and cost-effective manner; and,

WHEREAS, the Wasilla Planning Commission would like to recommend approval of this vacation, as a disposal of interest in land now designated for Discovery Drive, to the Wasilla City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that:

The Wasilla City Council has 30 days from the date the vacation was approved by the Mat-Su Borough Platting Board to veto the approval. The approval of the platting board was granted on December 28, 1995. If the City Council takes no action by January 28, 1996, the request is automatically approved under provisions of Title 29, Alaska Statutes. If the Council specifically affirms the approval, the remainder of the review period is waived and the applicants can begin developing a vacation plat for filing with the State Recorder's Office in order to complete the vacation.

The Wasilla Planning Commission voted to forward the approved vacation of a portion of the Discovery Drive right-of-way to the Wasilla City Council for its consideration. The Commission recommends that the approval, with conditions, be upheld by a motion of the Council so that the affected property owners can complete the vacation process.

The Commission finds that vacating a portion of Discovery Drive right-of-way, with conditions, will not impair the ability of the City, Borough or any public or private utility to provide services to the public in an efficient and cost-effective manner.

#### **CONDITIONS AND/OR REASONS**

The platting board approved the vacation of the 60' Discovery Drive access easement through Lots 1 and 3 and the attached 15' utility easement pursuant to AS 29.40.120 through AS 29.40.160 and MSB 16.15.035 contingent on the following:

- 1. Wasilla City Council approval within 30 days of Platting Board written decision;
- 2. Recordation of a plat showing:
  - a. Vacation of the 60' access easement of Discovery Drive;
  - b. Vacation of the utility easement;

- 8. Resolve road names with MSB platting staff.

#### **PUBLIC HEARINGS**


PUBLIC HEARING for VACATION OF PUBLIC USE EASEMENT & UTILITY EASEMENT, DISCOVERY DRIVE

# IF ROAD CONSTRUCTION IS REQUIRED PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- 1. Notice of cost estimate to be submitted by an engineer or a copy of the construction contract or the contractor's proposal, to be approved by the Borough Dept of Public Works.
- 2. Payment of a 2% fee based upon the approved estimate submitted.
- 3. Notice to proceed must be issued prior to construction as no road inspection is authorized without this notice.
