Subject: Summer Recreation & Training Swim Program.

The City of Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission and Parks and Recreation staff request your approval of already budgeted funding for this summers "Dollar Dip" swim, and swimming lessons program, that will be administered by the Mat-Su Borough. This program is patterned after the very successful program you approved for 1995 that attracted over 1,100 swimmers and involved more than 375 children in swimming lessons.

We request your authorization for:

- 1. 11 Monday "Dollar Dip" swim sessions that will run between 1 P.M. and 3 P.M. every Monday beginning June 10th and running through August 19th. for a total of \$3,300.00. (As in the past this means the City rents the Pool for a flat \$300 on each swim day. Any admissions during that period, at \$1.00 ea., come back to the City)
- 2. Reduced rate swimming lessons (Red Cross ages 6 and above and Pre-School ages 3-5) with a \$15 per student subsidy paid by Wasilla for 375 participants. The estimated cost is \$5,625.00.

Like last season the total estimated cost of both programs is \$8,925.00, before any refunds.

As in the past the City of Wasilla will be identified as "sponsor" on written materials and posted notice at the pool.
