**CIP Priorities** 

The Administration respectfully offers recommendations for FY97 CIP budget priorities. After general fund allocations of \$117,379 to water construction (Fund 08) and \$141,500 to sewer construction (Fund 14), \$680,229 \$561,350 remains available for general capital projects. The following recommended allocations would use all but \$65,696 of available FY97 capital money:
