SUBJECT: Spruce/Wasilla Fishhook/Peck Street Connection

The City Engineering Consultant, Dick Lowman called today saying that Ron Thiel, DOT/PF Engineer, had contacted him with a proposal to make the Peck/Spruce Connection to Fishhook Road.

As the administration had reminded DOT/PF this spring, the State has an overlay project underway for Fishhook, from Main Street to Schrock Road. Mr. Thiel called to say that with a contract amendment the State could accommodate the intersection grade and alignment revisions to meet the new city street. Wilder Construction is the contractor.

Dick Lowman will work the weekend to make a design proposal and cost estimate and this will be presented at the council meeting. The first blush costs to the City would be between \$50,000 and \$100,000 for Fishhook revisions alone, not the extension of Spruce or finished paving of Peck Street.

I believe, this is a big opportunity to get this road opened at a minimal cost, please hear Mr. Lowman and consider an ordinance to fund this project.
