SUMMARY:

Council Member Chappel would like to address the library funding shortfall in the FY-99 budget. The borough allocated \$322,000 for the Wasilla Public Library; this leaves a deficit of **\$30,397**.

After conversations with the borough finance department, it is confirmed that the funds allocated to the youth court program in FY-99 can not be used for any other program. These funds are specifically appropriated to youth court, and become available to the city on a reimbursable basis only.

The following options are presented for discussion:

OPTION #1:

In view of the deficit, reduce the expenses at the Wasilla Public Library.

OPTION #2:

Cover the short fall with funds from the general fund.

OPTION #3:

Pursue additional funding from the borough.
