## **SUMMARY:**

Four proposals were submitted for developing the Sewer Master Plan. Because they did not sign the "Offerer Statement of Qualifications" as required, two firms were declared non-responsive. The remaining two proposers, VEI Consultants and LCMF, Inc. were evaluated by a committee of four people. This committee unanimously selected LCMF Inc. as the consultant for a total cost of \$99,505.

The scope of services for the Sewer Master Plan will cover four areas:

- 1. Document sewer system capacity and operating costs.
- 2. Estimate service area growth and costs.
- 3. Evaluate transition from STEP to gravity sewer system. Subsection 3A. Evaluate gravity versus STEP collection system. Subsection 3B. Evaluate gravity versus STEP treatment system.
- 4. List potential treatment plant and/or disposal locations
