SUMMARY: The bid opening for this project was held at 2 p.m., August 18, 1999. Four bids were received. The bids were read aloud, as follows:

Pruhs Corporation	\$117,720.00
Wilder Construction	162,475.00
Koch Construction	194,840.00
Alaska Road Builders	201,780.00

I have reviewed the bids and found that the Wilder Construction and Pruhs Corporation bid documents contained one informality/irregularity each. Specifically:

- 1. Pruhs Corporation did not acknowledge receipt of Addendum #1. In discussions with the company, Pruhs stated that their bid price did not account for the items in the addendum. Pruhs' representative stated that their price would need to be increased. Public Works and the Administration did not accept Pruhs' proposal to increase their bid price by \$15,000 to account for the addendum items. To accept an increased bid price would be contrary to accepted bidding procedures. Therefore, Pruhs has withdrawn its bid (see attached letter of August 19<sup>th</sup>).
- 2. Wilder Construction did not describe their bid schedule amounts in words, using only numbers. Wasilla uses the Municipality of Anchorage specifications. Anchorage recently revised their specifications and now do not require words on bid sheets.

The bid documents for this project and existing ordinances allow the City to waive minor bid informalities/irregularities. Although the bid schedule requests that the bid include both words and numbers, Public Works and the Administration believe that this informality/irregularity should be waived as it did not affect the price and meets accepted bidding practices.

#### **RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

For Council to waive the bidding informality/irregularity for Wilder Construction, and to award the contract to Wilder Construction in the amount of \$162,475.
