

SUMMARY: Engineering design services are needed to prepare plans and bid documents for sewer plant aeration improvements.

BACKGROUND: This project is intended to improve sewage treatment and to lower maintenance costs. The project consists of installing new, high efficiency blowers and to change the aeration tubing to "moving chains/paddles. Through the Department of Environmental Conservation, the City received a State grant in the amount of \$309,000 for the estimated \$618,000 project.

LCMF, Inc. provided the preliminary engineering for this project last year. That preliminary engineering was a key factor in receiving the State grant. LCMF has submitted a proposed cost of \$35,058 for completing the design and for preparing bid documents.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: For Council to award the professional services contract to LCMF, Inc. in the amount of \$35,058.
