In accordance with state law, a local governing body may protest the approval of a liquor license application, by furnishing the ABC board and the applicant with a clear and concise written statement of reasons in support of a protest within 60 days of receipt of notice.

The clerk's office is requesting authorization to submit letters of **non-objection** to the ABC Board on behalf of applicants who are in compliance with Council Policy 95-03.

Should an applicant fail to comply with Council Policy 95-03, we fill forward the information to the council for final action. Objection letters **will not** be submitted to the ABC Board without final approval of the council.

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Council Policy No. 95-03


Title: Liquor License Renewals and Transfers

Council Policy No. 88-5 and 93-04 are hereby repealed. It is Council Policy to protest an application for a liquor license transfer or renewal if any of the following conditions exists:

1. Violation of WMC 2.60, Special Assessment Districts (delinquent payments);
2. Violation of WMC 5.10, Water Utility or WMC 5.20, Sewer Utility (delinquent payments);
3. Violation of WMC 6.50, Sales Tax;
4. Violation of WMC 9.04, Business License;
5. Violation of WMC 11.12, Litter, Sanitation Measures (trash enclosures);
6. Violation of WMC 14.04, Abandoned Vehicles and other property;
7. Violation of WMC 14.08, Encroachments;
8. Violation of WMC 16.43, Wasilla Development Code; or
9. Delinquent Taxes; i.e. Personal Property, Real Property, or Hotel/Motel Bed Tax.

Each Liquor License Renewal or Transfer shall also be submitted to the Wasilla Police Department for review, and Council may or may not take this into consideration when approving or protesting an application.

This policy becomes effective May 22, 1995.


