SUMMARY:

Evangelo's Restaurant has applied for a "Restaurant or Eating Place, public convenience" liquor license from the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (ABC Board), for the new restaurant they plan to open in the city. This particular type of liquor license allows the business to sell beer and wine only on-site. Unlike other types of liquor licenses, this license is *not* based on population and it is non-transferable.

Before the ABC board will grant the new license, they must receive a letter of concurrence from the council. If the council does not respond in writing, the license will not be granted.
