SUMMARY: Traffic studies indicate Lucille Street will become a major arterial in the future. A STIP nomination for this project will help secure future funding.

DISCUSSION: Improvements to surrounding roads is increasingly adding traffic to Lucille Street. Minimizing the expansion of Main Street, keeping a small town atmosphere, will focus traffic to Lucille Street and Crusey Street in the future. This project is intended to upgrade Lucille Street to a four lane with center median and turn lane that can handle large volumes of traffic and be aesthetically pleasing with bikepaths and street lighting.
