SUMMARY STATEMENT: The State of Alaska DOT has requested to participate in constructing the Tommy Moe Storm Drain System if storm water runoff from Fishhook Road can be diverted into the system. The contract amendment is needed to determine if the system can be expanded for the additional runoff.

The State of Alaska DOT is currently designing improvements for Wasilla-Fishhook Road within the City limits. The ADOT has evaluated its options for storm water runoff, and determined that participating in the City's Tommy Moe Storm Drain System is the most feasible option. Alternatively, ADOT will direct the Fishhook Road runoff through Main Street to the Parks Highway and into Cottonwood Creek or Lake Lucille. Preliminary engineering is needed to determine if the Tommy Moe Storm Drain System can be expanded to accommodate the additional runoff. ADOT has agreed to contribute all funds associated with their impact to the project, and to provide compensation for the long-term operation of the system.

STAFF RECOMMENDED ACTION: Council is requested to authorize the contract amendment in the Amount of \$50,000.
